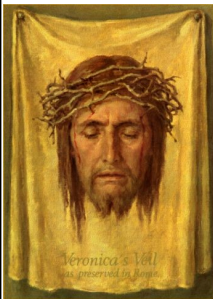
## SPRING LIFE RALLY

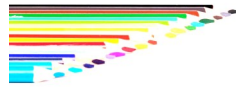

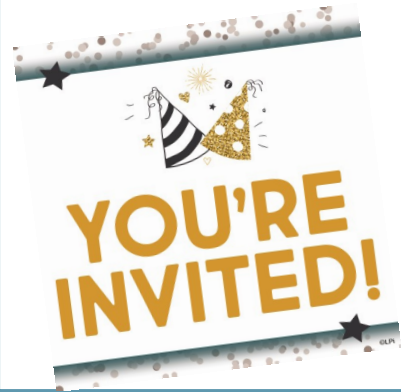
**Homeschooling Families:**
